Specialty Resident Training Bursary

\$25,000 a year bursary (taxable income) paid each year for up to two years (maximum \$50,000) for a resident in their final 2 years of study in a specialty training program, who has accepted a job offer in an eligible RSA community with a 1 year return of service agreement.

Recruitment Incentive Fund

One time financial incentive to move to designate RSA community

'A' communities – 20 or more points, **\$20,000** incentive

'B' communities – 15 to 19.9 points, **\$15,000** incentive

'C' communities – 6 to 14.9 points, **\$6,000** incentive

'D' communities – .5 to 5.9 points, **\$5,000** incentive

Rural Retention Program

Annual retention benefits: 30% of medical isolation points are paid as flat fee, 70% are paid as fee for service premium

Northern and Isolation Travel Assistance Outreach Program (NITAOP)

Radiology is an eligible specialty to receive travel time honorarium for visiting remote communities.

- Travel is reimbursed with receipts
 - Travel honorarium as follows:
 - Less than 2.5 hours = **\$250.00**
 - 2.5 to 4 hours = **\$500.00**
 - 4 to 10 hours = **\$1,000.00**
 - Greater than 10 hours = **\$1,500.00**

Rural Specialist Locum Program

- Eligible communities are: Campbell River, Comox, Courtenay, Cranbrook, Dawson Creek, Fort St. John, Kitimat, Nelson, Port Alberni, Powell River, Prince George, Prince Rupert, Quesnel, Salmon Arm, Sechelt, Smithers, Terrace, Trail, and Williams Lake
- MSP guarantees minimum pay of \$1,500/day, to be topped up by host physician and/or additional fee for service
- Accommodation reimbursed for A and B communities only using [government rates](#)
- Travel meal honorarium

- Travel time honorarium

Outbound Travel time is calculated from the time the physician leaves their residence to the arrival time in the community. Inbound travel time is calculated from the time the physician leaves the community to the arrival time back at home, to a maximum of \$1500.00 per return trip.

- Rental reimbursement
 - Receipts required for economy class car rental

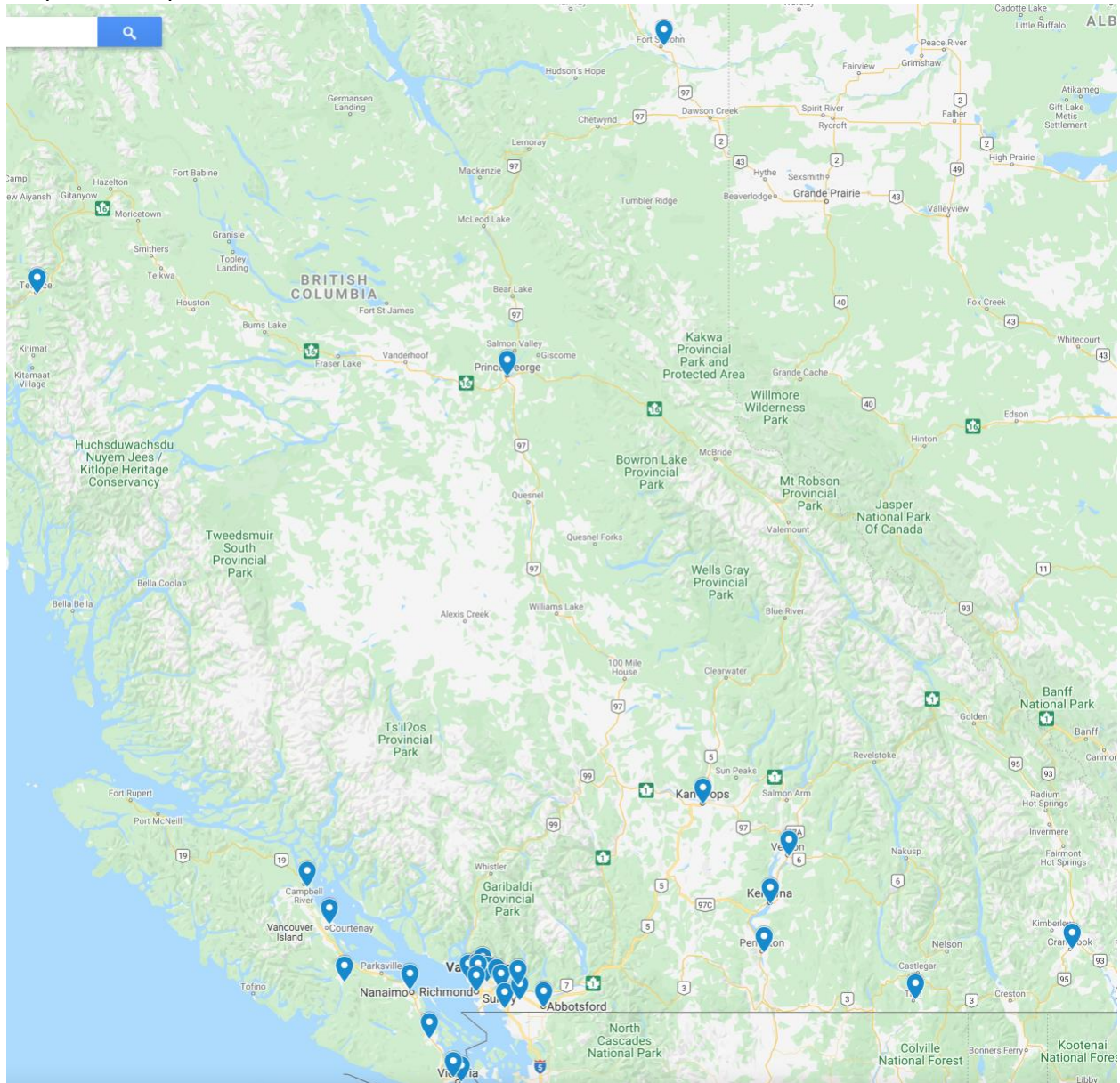
\$500 for completing 8 hour course on ICS, must work in RSA community
