Practice Details:

Fabulous opportunity for a highly motivated Radiologist to join our team at North Shore Medical Imaging. This opportunity is for a Locum position.

We are a group of 16 fellowship trained Radiologists centred in North Vancouver where we serve the entire population of the North Shore. We provide service to Lions Gate Hospital and the other VCH facilities within the Coastal Community of Care (Squamish, Whistler, Pemberton, Sechelt, Powell River, and the North Coast). We own, operate and staff our local community imaging clinic (North Shore Medical Imaging).

Our practice is widely varied, but in general we offer all modalities throughout our geographically dispersed sites including: Xray, CT, MRI, US, MG, Echo and Bone Densitometry. We also offer a full IR service based out of LGH (but also with some services in our peripheral sites) which includes arterial work in addition to all routine procedures.

Our community imaging clinic operates in two separate locations in North Vancouver and West Vancouver and offers US, Xray, mammography, Bone Densitometry and MRI.

We are seeking a highly motivated, fellowship trained and Canadian certified Radiologist to join our team as a locum. We will consider all fellowships, but our job mandates that in addition to your sub specialty we have and maintain competence in our general qualifications as we all perform basic procedures, read MRI and US from all areas of the body and report diagnostic mammography and bone density.

Qualifications:

- Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada (FRCPC) in good standing
- Eligible for licensure with CPSBC (Coverage with the Canadian Medical Protective Association is mandatory)
- Strong general radiology skills including X-ray, ultrasound, CT and MRI, mammography including obstetrical and MSK ultrasound
- Strong skills in image guided biopsy and drainage including CT-, ultrasound and fluoroscopy-guided procedures.
- Echocardiography may be available to qualified candidates.
- Willing to travel to different geographic sites during the work week.

- Fellowship training is highly desirable, particularly in IVR, Breast and Echocardiography, but not required.

Call Schedule:

- Hours of work: Full Time with some travel (Squamish, Whistler, Sechelt).
- On call requirements: No on call for locums

Locum Length:

- Negotiable, but anticipated to be a minimum of 6-12 months. Potential for longer term.
