Prospective radiologists should be comfortable with general radiology, including Fluoroscopy, ultrasound, CT and MRI, as well as basic image guided interventional procedures. A fellowship is not a necessity. Candidates must hold Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada certification in radiology (FRCPC) and be eligible for full licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC (CPSBC).

All locum opportunities are eligible for travel funding through the Rural Specialists Locum Program.
